Recent Events

Tuesday evening, December 9th, she will be performing the entire G. F.Handel Concerto (her own edition) and C. Saint-Sæns 'Morceau de Concert' with Clark McAlister and the Century Village (Deerfield) Symphony Orchestra.

Alice Chalifoux [Principal Harpist of The Cleveland Orchestra from 1931-1974] who recently passed away had a big impact on the harpists in South Florida.
