The American Harp Society is pleased to announce that the 19th American Harp Society National Competition will be held beginning the week of June 19, 2011 at the University of North Texas in Denton, Texas.

The competition is open to harpists up to the age of 30 who are national members of the American Harp Society and who are United States citizens or who are citizens of the Americas.

Finalists will be chosen by a recorded preliminary round and will be notified 30 days prior to the start of the competition. Finalists will compete in person.
