Participants must supply their own instrument, bench, music, and music stand. The AHS may be able to make referrals to local harpists for rental instruments; participants are also encouraged to contact vendors to arrange for a rental harp if necessary. Load-in to the rehearsal space is on one level from the free parking lot, and secure storage will be available between rehearsals.
