Section 4 - Housing

Off campus: Discounted rates for AHS 2023 Summer Institute & National Competition attendees are available at the Omni Hotel at California Plaza in downtown Los Angeles, immediately adjacent to the Colburn School.

For this special group rate, the daily \$30 Destination Fee has been waived, and deluxe WiFi is included. Overnight discounted valet parking is \$42/night.* If you wish to vacation a bit in Los Angeles before or after the event, the discounted rate is available May 27 through June 7. Cancellation 72 hours or more prior to arrival will avoid a 1-night room and tax penalty. Reservations <u>must</u> be made using the link below to obtain the group discount rate. **Reservation deadline: May 9, 2023.**

On campus: The Colburn School offers resident hall suites available with double or single occupancy bedrooms, and are furnished with everything you'll need: extra-long twin beds; desks/chairs; nightstands with lamps; and wardrobes. There is also a shared common area in the suite with one or two bathrooms, standard living room furniture, including a Roku television, and a kitchenette (microwave, mini-fridge, and cabinet space.) A laundry room is located on the second floor of the Olive Building.

Important note: The Colburn School and the American Harp Society, its officers, employees, independent contractors, and/or volunteers do not provide guardianship services for unaccompanied minors attending events. It is the responsibility of the parents of unaccompanied minors, and they are so notified, to provide for a guardian for their minor child and to follow all rules set forth in the policies of the venues where events are located. The Colburn School requires students to be age 13 or older to stay in the Residence Hall, and have a signed Medical Consent Form (supplied by Colburn) from a parent or guardian.
